- 2. Ensure the selection of technologies that meet the functional abilities of the end user (e.g., perceptual, motor, or cognitive disorders).
- 3. Ensure the selection of technologies that meet the end user's skill level and personality (e.g., motivation, distrust, anxiety).
- 4. Consider the prerequisites for installing the technology (e.g., internet connection, WiFi, possession of a smartphone).
- 5. Identify the resources that the end-user has access to in their ecosystem and try to integrate them into the implementation and maintenance of the technology.



1. Sleep habits

In this section, In this section, we will discuss technologies that affect sleep patterns. As people age, they are more prone to various disorders such as sleep apnea, insomnia and restless leg syndrome. In addition, older people often experience changes such as a decrease in deep sleep and an increase in wakefulness during the night. Sleep monitoring technologies aim to help older adults track sleep quality by allowing them to examine their sleep cycle, heart rate, and breathing during the night. Other technologies, such as bed shakers, are also available for individuals with hearing or visual difficulties.

2. Medication management

In this section, you will find medication management devices, including traditional pillboxes with timers and electronic pillboxes. Pillboxes have the potential to help older adults manage their medications more easily and effectively. Traditional pillboxes can be paired with a timer or watch with reminder alarms to alert the user when it is time to take their medication. Electronic pillboxes, on the other hand, have built-in audible alarms or flashing lights that alert the user when it's time to take their medication. Some are portable and can even send notifications of missed doses.
